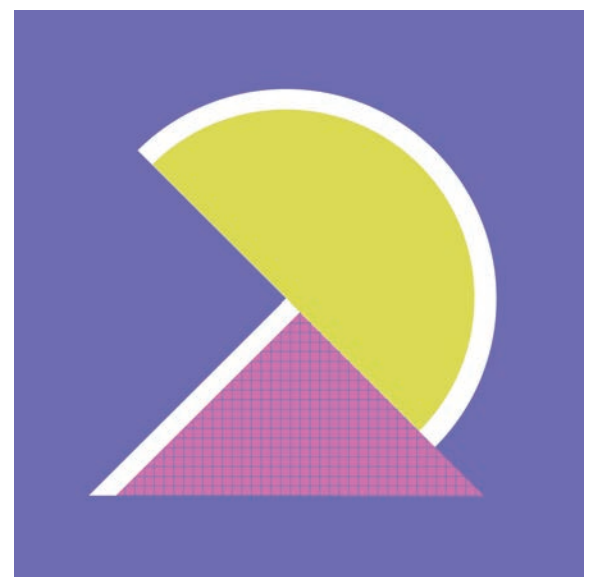

Look out for our vendors!

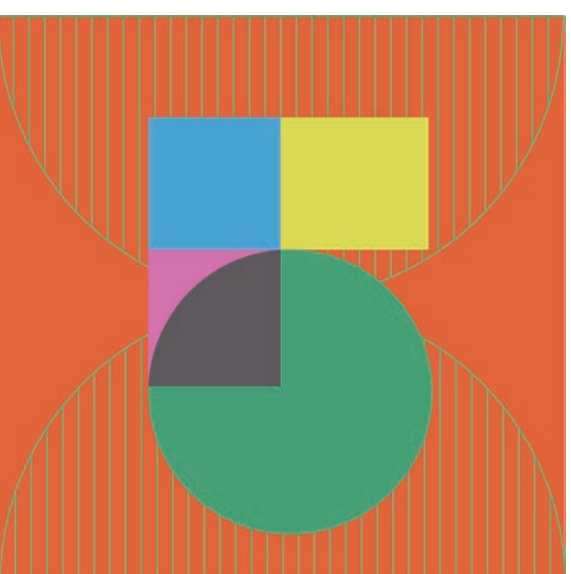
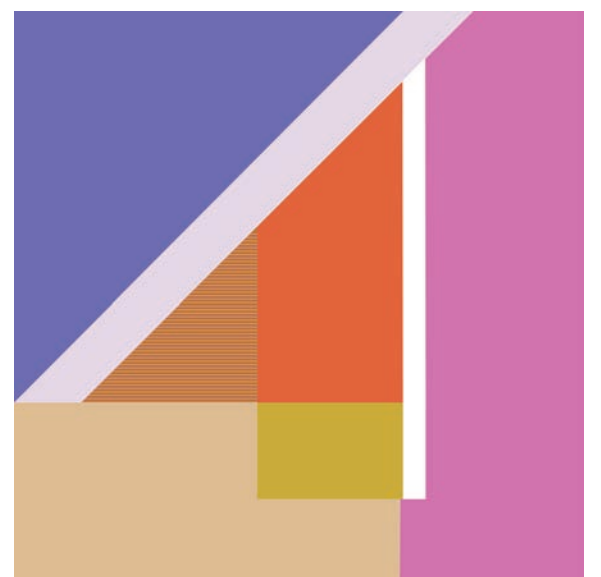

Snap a picture in the AGGV Giant Frame! Capture the moment with your friends, family, and neighbours.

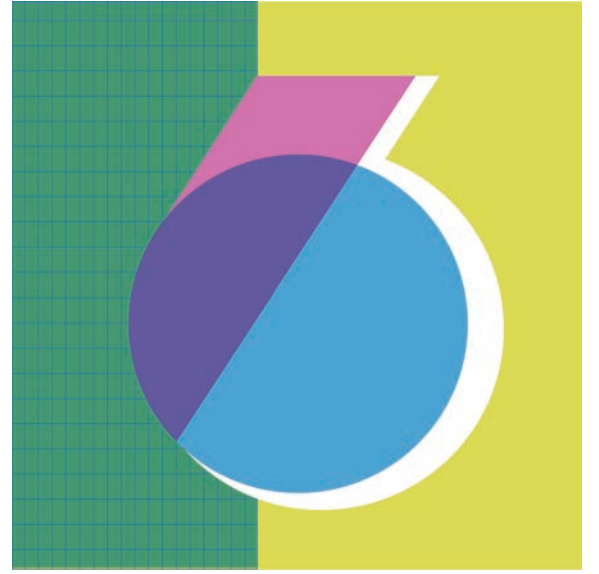
While you are here check out our new mural by the New Extreme Youth Art Mentorship Program.

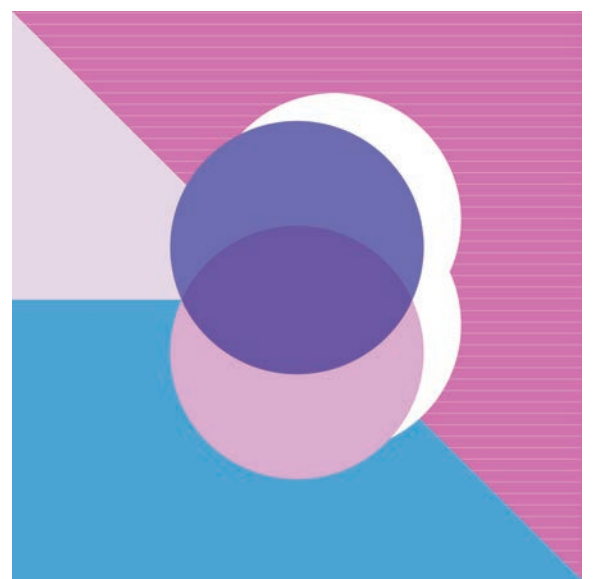
