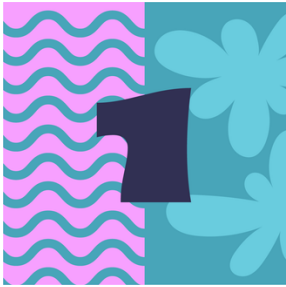
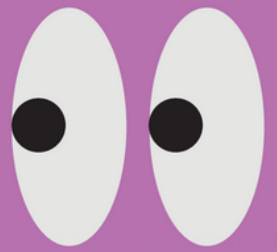

This year there will be some construction happening on Dallas Road and at the base of Moss Street, so please take note that the Art Gallery Paint-In will run from Fort Street all the way down to Clover Ave this year.

Moss Street will boast over 160 artists set up on the boulevard, so we suggest starting at Clover Ave and making your way up to the Art Gallery of Greater Victoria (1040 Moss St) to soak in all of the amazing creative talent Vancouver Island has to offer. No matter where you start "Painting the Town", be sure to stop at the top of the hill by the AGGV to enjoy local food, beverages and entertainment!

VISIT IMAGINATION STATIONS AND PET STATIONS, TOO

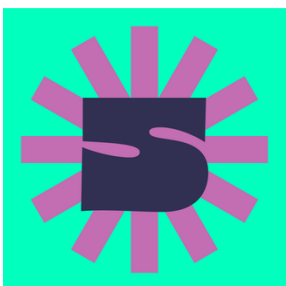
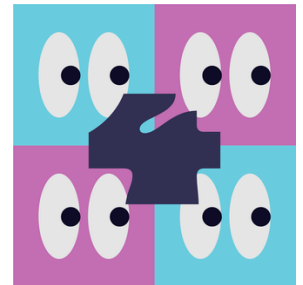

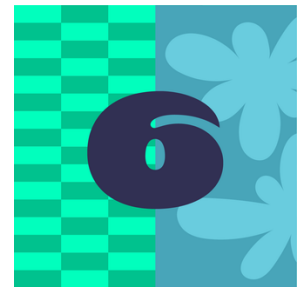

Also, stop and say hi at the Ocean 98.5 and Jack FM tents, where they'll be keeping Victoria up-to-date on all things Paint-In, all day.



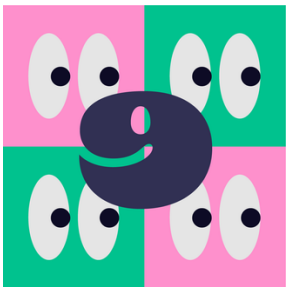
GET SOME R&R AND REFRESH YOURSELF AT THE FAMILY-FRIENDLY BEER GARDEN

GO GREEN AND SNAG A BAG

In our ongoing commitment to being a GREEN event, we are once again working with The Diverters for the 35th Annual Art Gallery Paint-In! The Diverters are "dedicated to creating economic opportunities, de-stigmatizing diverting (bottle collection, waste picking, or binning), diverting waste, and promoting social cohesion among members of the diverter community". They will be located at 1080 Moss Street as well as every recycling station on the street to help you with any waste and recycling during the festival.

And what better way to go green while shopping local artists than using a lovely re-usable canvas tote bag? Our new stylin' Paint-In zippered tote bags will be available for purchase at the Gallery Shop, Membership Booth and all of our Information Booths. Start your Paint-In shopping spree right – snag a bag to show your support of the Art Gallery Paint-In on July 20, and all year round!

BE SAFE, STAY HEALTHY, AND HAVE FUN!

- This year we will have 3 Rest Stations dotted along Moss Street providing shelter and seating for those who need to get off their feet and cool off.
- Make sure to drink lots of water and bring your own water bottles! You can refill your bottles at the Gallery's bottle fountain in the lobby, and at the CRD Water Station located at 1040 Moss.
- Portable washrooms are located at Clover Ave, Fairfield Road, and 1040 Moss. You can also use the gender-neutral restrooms at the AGGV as well as the Moss Street Market restrooms.
- Be prepared for the sun and heat! Bring hats, sunscreen, and anything else you might need to keep you cool.
- Bringing your bike? Drop it off at the Capital Bike Locker, located at Central Middle School.
- Need any assistance during the festival? Our purple-shirted Volunteers and orange-shirted AGGV Staff are here to help! You can find them at our yellow donation bins or Information Booths.
- You can also speak with Victoria Police who will be located at all major intersections. The Missing Child Meeting Station and Assistance Centre are at the Art Gallery of Greater Victoria Front Desk.
- Need medical or emergency help? Elite Security will be providing security and first-aid all day at the Paint-In, including two sets of roaming first aid professionals. There will be an ambulance placed between Willspencer and Fort, and there is a First Aid Tent near George St.
